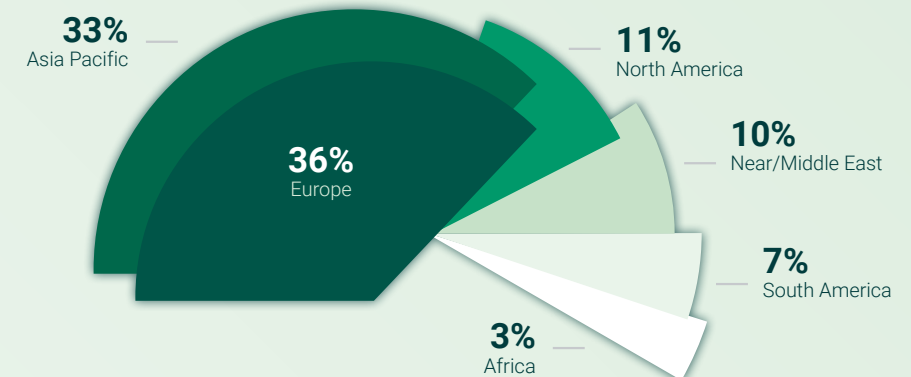

Customise your programme: Elective courses and field trips

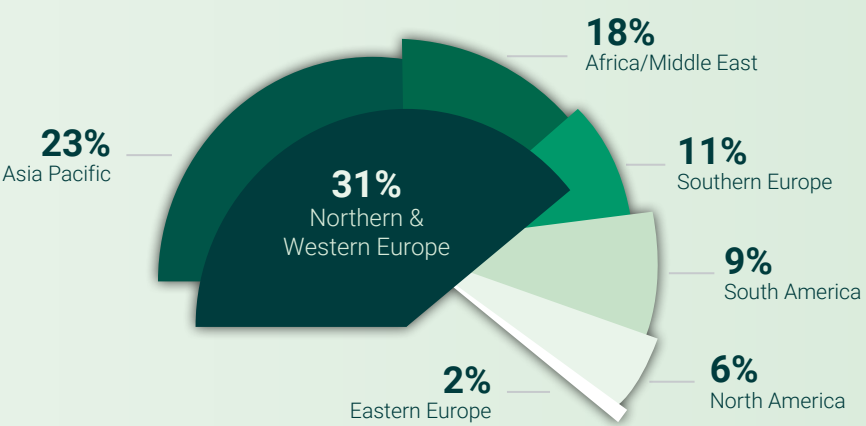

Your journey starts here

Admissions process

All elements of your application will be thoroughly reviewed by the Admissions Team. The selection process will take up to ten weeks from the date of completed application submission.



Admissions criteria

Academic capacity
Strong analytical skills and proven ability to succeed in an intense programme.

International motivation
Curiosity and openness to diverse cultures and perspectives.

Ability to contribute
Unique perspectives and experiences that enrich the class.

Leadership potential
Evidence of initiative, responsibility, and the ability to inspire others.

Application rounds

We operate a staged admissions process, with four rounds for each intake. Competition for each of the rounds is equal, but the earlier you gain admission, the more time you have to secure financing and arrange logistics. The application form typically opens two months before the first round for each intake.

Language policy

Our MBA programme is taught exclusively in English. If English is neither your mother tongue nor the language in which your university degree was taught, you will need a certification of proficiency

in English such as the TOEFL, IELTS or PTE Academics. If English is your mother tongue, you will instead need to provide proof of intermediate-level ability in one other official language.
